Information

Leeds Beckett is well connected. It has excellent public transport, cycling and walking facilities. Our City Centre sites are all within easy walking distance of Leeds Rail Station. Headingley Campus is 3 miles from the City Centre, there is a bus every 3 minutes between the City Centre and Headingley Mon – Sat daytimes and there are also services to Headingley Campus itself. Frequent bus services connect all our halls of residence and popular student areas to our City and Headingley Campuses.

Leeds City Bus & City Bus South Bank (service 70)

The Leeds City Bus links bus and rail stations with our City Campus (Portland Way bus stop). The cost is 50p per journey. Day/season ticket, MetroCard and MCard holders travel for free. The service runs every few minutes from 6.30am to 7.30pm Monday to Saturday. There is a daily First service 70 linking Leeds Rail Stn with Leeds Dock and Liberty Dock Halls of Residence.

yournextbus

yournextbus provides scheduled or predicted times of buses. The eight-digit number starting '450' on the bus stop, shelter or timetable is the number of the stop, which you can enter at www.wymetro.com or text to 63876 to find out the next departures.

Text costs: Outbound texts are charged at your standard rate. Returned texts are charged at a maximum of 12p.

Discounted Travel Passes and Fares

There are a lot to choose from so make sure you check which operator runs the service(s) you'll be using and consider whether you'll need a pass for bus and rail before you buy to make sure you save as much money as possible.



Bus operators offer their own **day, weekly, monthly and term** tickets. Yorkshire Tiger (services 29, 38 and 69) offers a £2.50* day fare for Leeds Beckett staff and students on production of your university ID card and a £9.00* weekly ticket. First offers various student tickets. Multi-operator Day Rover tickets can be used on any bus and rail service in West Yorkshire.

16-25/Student MCard – The money saving 16-25/Student MCard means you pay just once a week, once a month or per term and enjoy virtually unlimited bus and train travel throughout West Yorkshire. They're available from Bus Stations, Travel Centres, or apply for your first 16-25/Student MCard at www.m-card.co.uk using a passport or driving license to verify your age and upload your photo. Once you've received your 16-25/Student MCard in the post, you're ready to top up with weekly, monthly or termly bus and train travel. Top up at Bus Station Travel Centres and Payzone outlets in West Yorkshire and pay £22 a week, £82 a month, £243 for Autumn Term 14/09/15 to 18/12/15; £189 for Spring Term 04/01/16 to 18/03/16; £129 for Summer Term 04/04/16 to 03/06/16.* Bus and train companies, such as First and Northern, offer reduced rates to students if you buy a PhotoCard and tickets in advance.

Cycling and Bike Hire

Students can hire a bike for just £35* for a semester or £50* for the academic year plus £100* returnable deposit. All bikes come complete with lights, mudguards, rack, lock, and servicing.

The Bike Hub near City Campus and BikeFix at Headingley Campus are open to all staff and students for bike hire, self-help cycle maintenance, cycle confidence training and much more. Leeds Beckett University Area Map

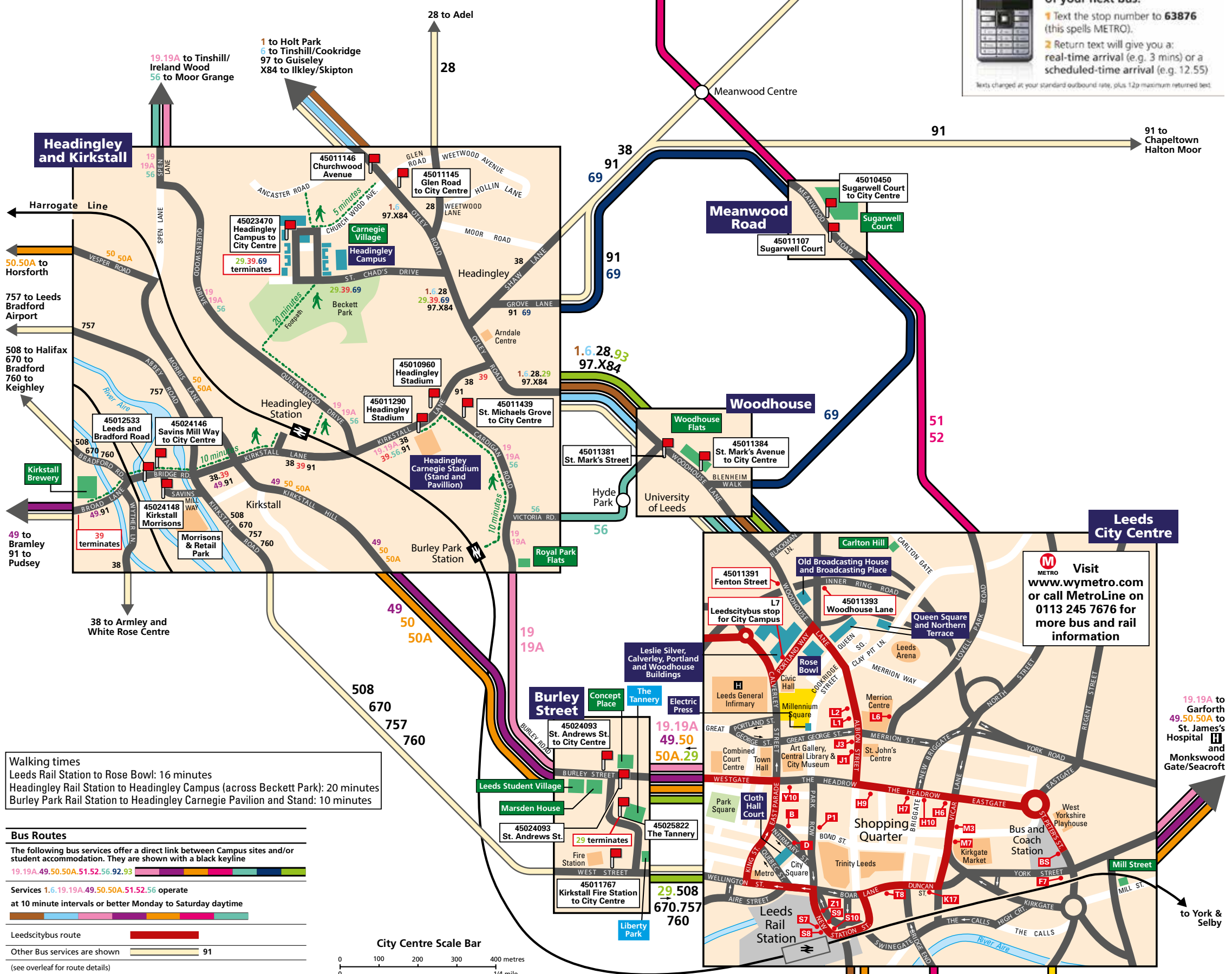

When's the next? Just text!

2 simple steps to get the time of your next bus.

- 1 Text the stop number to **63876** (this spells METRO).
- 2 Return text will give you a: real-time arrival (e.g. 3 mins) or a scheduled-time arrival (e.g. 12.55)

Texts charged at your standard outbound rate, plus 12p maximum returned text.

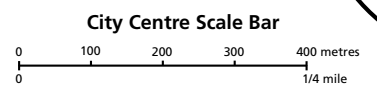

LeedsCitybus route

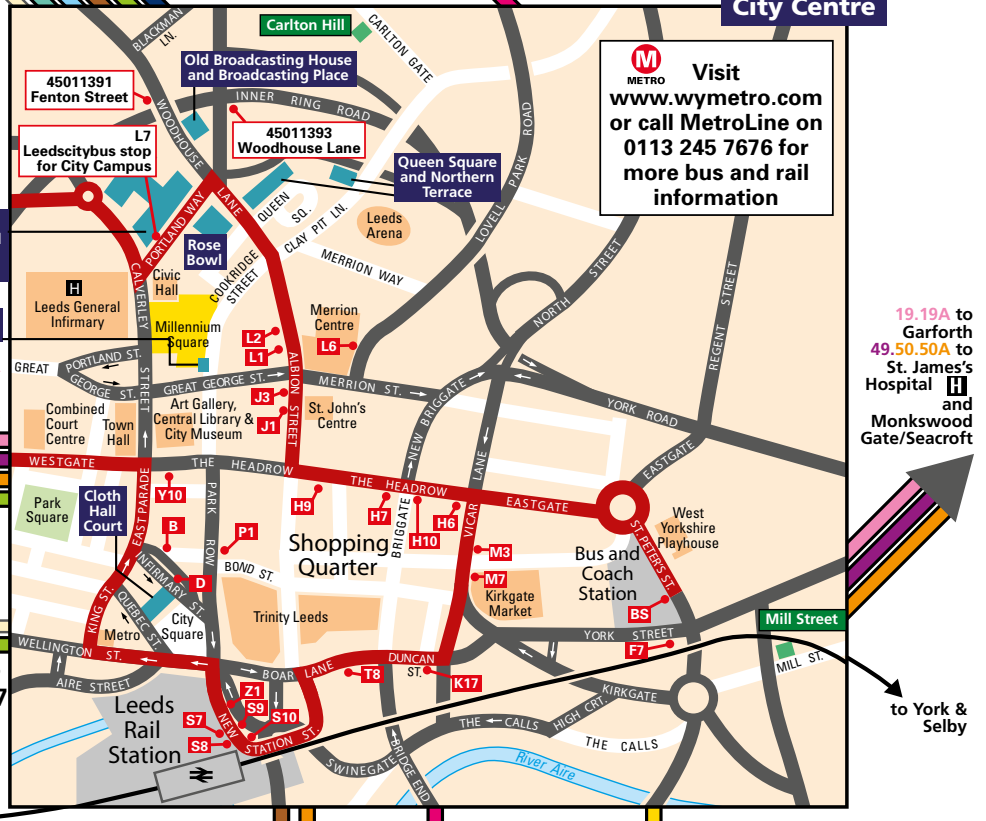
